

Instructions for Test Corrections

- You will need your book and your notes to complete test corrections.
- **Step 1:** Write down the letter of the correct answer.
- **Step 2:** Write down the page number or set of notes where you found the correct answer.
- **Step 3:** Explain why your original answer was historically inaccurate.
- **If you got a 69% or below:** After completing your test corrections, go back and tell me why your score was low and what you will do next time to improve.
- **EXAMPLE:**
 - 1.B, p.214, George Washington could not have been president during the Civil War because he was already dead.
 - 2.D, Manifest Destiny notes, This answer is incorrect because America never bought Mexico.
 - NOT THIS: *I didn't study; I read the question wrong; I marked the wrong bubble*
